Grading Chart:

<i>Third Quarter Grade</i>	<i>Factors used to determine 4th quarter grade</i>	<i>Final second semester grade</i>
A	Student participated in a minimum of 65% of class meetings and work assigned by teacher, as determined by the teacher	A
B	Student participated in a minimum of 65% of class meetings and work assigned by teacher, as determined by the teacher	A or B depending on the level and quality of the student's work
C	Student participated in a minimum of 65% of class meetings and work assigned by teacher, as determined by the teacher	A, B, or C depending on the level and quality of the student's work
D	Student participated in a minimum of 65% of class meetings and work assigned by teacher, as determined by the teacher	A, B, C, D depending on the level and quality of the student's work
F	Student participated in a minimum of 65% of class meetings and work assigned by teacher, as determined by the teacher	A, B, C, D depending on the level and quality of the student's work

Note:

- If a student fails to complete 65% of assignments, class meetings or activities, the second semester grade will be calculated as the third quarter grade.
- For 4th and 5th grade, if a student fails to complete 65% of assignments, class meetings or activities, the 4th quarter grade will be calculated as the third quarter grade.

E	Student participated in a minimum of 65% of class meetings and work assigned by teacher, as determined by the teacher	E
S+/S/S-	Student participated in a minimum of 65% of class meetings and work assigned by teacher, as determined by the teacher	S+ or S depending on the level and quality of the student's work
N	Student participated in a minimum of 65% of class meetings and work assigned by teacher, as determined by the teacher	S+, S, S- or N depending on the level and quality of the student's work
U	Student participated in a minimum of 65% of class meetings and work assigned by teacher, as determined by the teacher	S+, S, S- or N depending on the level and quality of the student's work
